



Dean's NEH Summer Stipend Awards

Two Awards per year, \$6000 each

The College of Arts and Sciences is initiating a new internal grant program aimed at enhancing the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) Summer Stipend program.

In order to stimulate proposal submissions and to facilitate research in the humanities, the College of Arts and Sciences will provide summer stipends of \$6000 to two faculty members submitting proposals to the internal competition for the National Endowment for the Humanities Summer Stipends program. This funding will assure that at least two summer stipends are awarded (with internal funding). If one or two applicants are funded by NEH, then three or four awards will result. The top two proposals, in other words, will be assured of funding, and one or two other proposals may be funded. Award winners will be notified following notification of any award notices from NEH in March, 2010.

Submissions for the Summer 2010 internal competition are due August 25, 2009.
