

SRS GIS TECHNICIAN

Position Description:

Entry level GIS technician to work as a team member in the Process & Geographic Software Engineering (PGSE) group at the Savannah River Site. Duties include using GIS and CAD to produce maps to meet customer requirements. Additional duties include data creation and editing, digitizing, and data entry in a GIS and/or CAD environment. The CAD/GIS technician will support the overall mission of the PGSE group.

Background and History:

The Savannah River Site (SRS) is a US Department of Energy facility located in Aiken County South Carolina and is approximately 25 miles from Augusta, Georgia and 20 miles from Aiken, South Carolina. GIS plays an integral role at SRS and is utilized in a variety of ways at SRS. GIS is used at SRS for environmental clean-up, emergency operations, facility operations, and safety & security.

Required Skills:

Good computer knowledge and skills and proficiency working in various software applications in the Microsoft Windows environment. Experience and knowledge with Microsoft Office products is required such as Word, Excel, and Power Point.

Desired Skills:

One or two years of experience working in GIS is desired using the ESRI ArcGIS platform. Experience in CAD/drafting using Microstation is also desired.

Education:

High School diploma is required. An Associates and/or Bachelor's degree in drafting, computers, or Geographic Information Systems or closely related field is desired.
