CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Yes, believe it or not, it is already time to start thinking about our annual South Carolina GIS Conference to be held next year at the [Metropolitan Convention Center](#) in downtown Columbia. We invite you to share your knowledge and special projects with others by submitting a one paragraph abstract for presentation in February.

Each presentation session will be one hour in length with 5 minutes for a moderator introduction, 45 minutes for the presentation, and 10 minutes for Q & A. We ask that presentations be given as a solution to a problem or issue. The speaker should discuss the problem, research, solution and results. Vendors may also present solutions as a shared presentation with the contracting agency.

We are asking for input in one of two ways for our Program Committee to use for the conference agenda.

1. The presentation should be based on the theme of using GIS to help provide solutions you have put in place. Presentations can include any GIS activity, or related hardware and software, and fit the outline given above. We will ask for a short (1 paragraph) abstract for your presentation.
2. This is also a call for presentation ideas and nominations for presentations seen at other conferences that would be of value to those attending this conference. Even if you don't know the presenter personally, send us their name, agency and topic. We can contact them to determine if they are interested in speaking.
