Collecting and presenting South Carolina's culture, history, and physical environment is a vital part of USC's McKissick Museum. McKissick exhibitions, based on current scholarship and University research, provide engaging presentations of art, material culture, history, and natural science. Their broad content focuses on the diversity and richness of regional culture. The Folklife Resource Center is open to the general public and is a repository for audio, visual, and printed materials documenting Southern folk arts and traditions. Educational opportunities such as lectures, tours, and social gatherings are offered year-round and provide opportunities for adults, families, and students to enjoy learning about museum collections and projects.
