

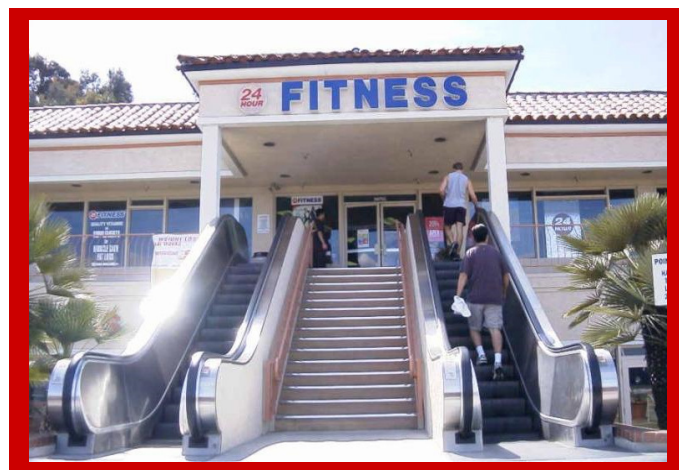
## Irony and Ethics
